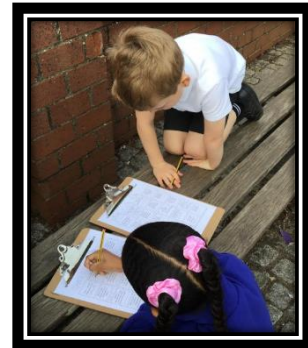


Shakespeare Week

Well done to everyone! Beaudesert are very proud of you!

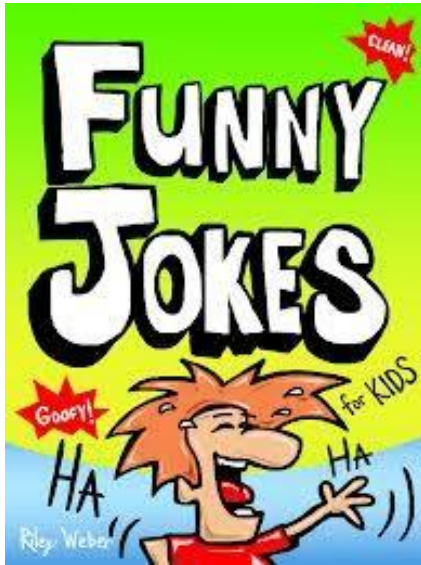


Year 4 Rainforest Workshop

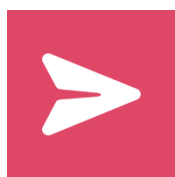
Change of contact details/address

If you have changed your address or phone number recently, please let the school office know your new details. Thank you.



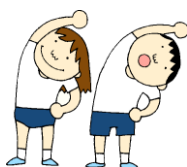
Absences/lateness
